We had a great turnout for both of our Streaming 101 Workshops held on August 5 and August 19. Members and nonmembers joined us for interactive, hands-on sessions designed to take the mystery out of streaming and help make “cutting the cord” from traditional TV providers a little easier.

Led by our Network Coordinator, Scot Cunningham, the workshop walked participants through what streaming is, how it works, the internet speeds needed for a smooth experience, and how to access local channels and favorite shows. Attendees also learned how to use tools like MyBundle to build a custom streaming lineup that fits their preferences.

Participants were engaged from start to finish, asking questions and sharing their own experiences. Scot answered questions as the workshop progressed, making the session easy to follow and interactive. Many attendees were excited to see how the MyBundle tool on our website could simplify the process of finding streaming services that best match their needs.

The MyBundle tool makes it easy to compare and select from the many streaming options available, giving members confidence that they are signing up for the services that work best for them.
