


NEW Rates, NEW Choices:



What you need to know



No one welcomes a rate increase but understanding why it's happening and how you can respond puts the power back in your hands.

Beginning October 1, 2025, Southeastern Indiana REMC will implement a rate adjustment that will result in an average increase of approximately 8.5% for members. This change is necessary to keep pace with rising power supply costs, inflation in materials, labor and the investments needed to maintain a reliable and resilient electric system.

We understand that any increase in your monthly bill can feel like a burden. That's why we're giving you choices—so you can decide what works best for your household.

Residential members can stay on the A-5 Residential Electric Service rate, which charges a two block rate for every kilowatt-hour of electricity you use, or you can choose the new Time-of-Day rate (a revised version of the rate formerly known as Time-of-Use Critical Peak Pricing), which offers different prices based on the time of day you use energy. Under the Time-of-Day rate, electricity costs less during off-peak hours—like early mornings, late evenings and weekends—and more during peak hours, typically weekday afternoons and early evenings when demand is highest.

To help you make an informed decision, SEI REMC will provide a side-by-side comparison using your actual past energy usage. This analysis will show whether the Time-of-Day rate could save you money based on how you already use electricity. This personalized report is available upon request.

By shifting even a few tasks to off-peak times—like running the dishwasher after 8 p.m. or delaying laundry until the weekend—you may be able to increase your savings even more.

We also offer a prepay billing option, which allows you to load funds in advance and monitor your usage daily. This can help you stay on top of your budget and avoid surprises when your bill arrives.
