While each individual contribution may be small, together they create opportunities for projects that have a lasting impact.

One recent example of this impact can be seen in Ohio County, where the Ohio County Soil and Water Conservation District received a \$1,400 Operation RoundUp® grant to install permanent signage at the Community Pollinator Garden located at Denver Siekman Park in Rising Sun.

This garden was established to support local pollinator populations by providing a habitat filled with native, nectar-producing plants. Butterflies, bees, and other pollinators rely on these spaces, which play an important role in maintaining healthy ecosystems and supporting local agriculture.

In addition to its environmental benefits, the pollinator garden serves as an ongoing educational resource for the community. The Ohio County SWCD uses the space to provide hands-on learning opportunities, helping individuals and families understand how to create and maintain pollinator-friendly environments at home.

Grants like this allow local organizations to expand their impact, enhance public spaces, and provide valuable education that benefits the entire community. By supporting projects like the Community Pollinator Garden, Operation RoundUp® helps create lasting resources that continue to serve and inspire for years to come.
