



Community support heats up with Operation RoundUp

Thanks to the generosity of Southeastern Indiana REMC members who participate in the Operation RoundUp program, the first round of community grants for 2025 has been awarded—providing a much-needed boost to local organizations working hard to make a difference.

Operation RoundUp gives members the opportunity to “round up” their monthly electric bill to the nearest dollar. These small contributions—typically just 50 cents per month on average—are pooled together to fund charitable projects and programs that benefit the communities we serve.

In July, the Operation RoundUp board reviewed applications and selected recipients based on impact and alignment with the program’s mission to support local food, shelter, clothing, health, education, and public safety needs in Southeastern Indiana REMC’s seven-county community. In total, \$47,000 was distributed during this first round.

With this round of awards, Operation RoundUp has now surpassed \$1 million in total grants given since the program’s inception—a remarkable milestone made possible by the continued support of our members.
